Re: Instructions – Colorado Certificate of Exemption

Dear CSU Faculty and Staff,

Colorado State University is exempt from Colorado state-administered sales tax on purchases made for official university business using university funds. To utilize this exemption:

### **Present the Certificate of Exemption (Form DR 0160)**

- Always present Form DR 0160 (attached) to the vendor to confirm CSU's tax-exempt status.
- Ensure purchases are made with university funds (e.g., procurement card or purchase order).

### **Complete the Declaration of Sales Tax Exemption (Form DR 5002) If Requested**

- If the vendor requests additional documentation, complete and sign Form DR 5002 (attached):
  - **Line 3b:** Mark the type of qualifying payment.
  - **Line 5:** Provide your signature, printed name, title, and date.
- Employees without delegated signature authority may complete and sign this form as confirmed by CSU's Office of General Counsel.

### **Verification of Exemption**

- Vendors wishing to verify CSU's tax-exempt status may visit the Colorado Department of Revenue's **Revenue Online** portal at: <https://www.colorado.gov/revenueonline/#1>.
- Vendors should enter CSU's exemption number: **09802381**.

### **Important Notes**

- Vendors may request additional documentation to confirm CSU's tax-exempt eligibility.
- Some vendors may choose not to honor the exemption. If refused, consider selecting another supplier.
- This exemption applies only to purchases made with CSU funds for official university use. Personal or reimbursable purchases are not eligible.
